Justin Legris, a Fort Smith Christmas Honors volunteer since the inception of the event in 2009, is a dedicated music educator and proud member of the Arkansas Army National Guard.

A product of the Fort Smith Public School system, he is a 2008 graduate of Fort Smith Southside High School and is a music educator at Springhill Elementary School in Greenbrier, Ark. There he instills a love of music in hundreds of students from kindergarten through fifth grade and mentors future music educators from the University of Central Arkansas.

Upon graduating from Southside he studied Music Education at the University of Central Arkansas where he also became an active member of the Kappa Kappa Psi National Honorary Band Service Fraternity. He later followed his future wife to Nashville, Tenn. where he attended Belmont University graduating with a Bachelor of Music degree in instrumental Music Education in 2015.

After Legris' first year of teaching, he became a charter member of the faculty at the new Springhill Elementary school in 2016. He has since been honored with a variety of district level and national awards including a Grammy Award nomination and a Country Music Award nomination. He also serves his church, St. Joseph Catholic Church in Conway, as a Minister of Music in addition to performing around the state



In the summer of 2020 he answered "The Call" and began an important chapter in his life by becoming a member of the Arkansas Army National Guard. He attended Basic Training as an Army Specialist at Fort Leonard Wood, Mo., and graduated in the summer of 2021. After Basic Training he immediately entered Officer Candidate School at Fort Benning, Ga., and graduated this past September as a Second Lieutenant as part of the Army Quartermaster Corps. He currently serves as a platoon leader with the 39th Brigade 2nd Infantry Battalion 153rd Regiment H Company BSB in Cabot, Ark.

Following his six months of study with the US Army, he returned to Conway, surprising his two children, Elizabeth and William, as well as the entire faculty and student body at Springhill with his return home. As a result of this surprise homecoming, Legris was featured on KARK television in Little Rock as a part of their weekly "Good News Arkansas" segment.

He has a deeply rooted love for his family, his wife and college sweetheart Stephanie Legris, and his two children Elizabeth, age 5, and William, age 3. He also has a passionate love for his country, the Greenbrier, Conway and Fort Smith communities, and all veterans and their families as a member of the Christmas Honors team. At the conclusion of today's program he will pay tribute to all branches of the military by once again sounding Taps.


